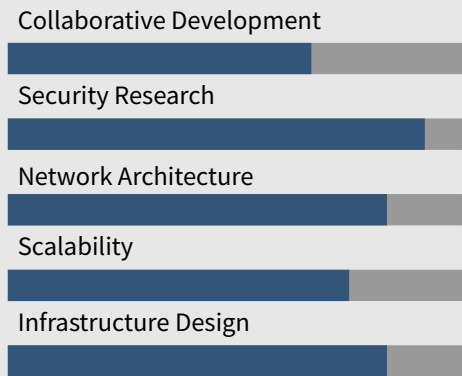

Established a hosting environment for friends and family consisting of 7 nodes distributed geographically hosting in excess of 50 domains. Allows research and deployment of progressively-enhanced Internet technologies. At present, all public-facing nodes are Dual-Homed (IPv4 and IPv6), all hosted DNS zones are DNSSEC-signed, all e-mail filtered (by constrained nodes, single CPU, 128 MiB RAM) with public zones SPF-, DKIM- and DMARC-protected. IPsec VPN endpoints exist on a variety of servers. Monitoring environments are tuned to emit only actionable notices for real-time intervention as needed. All public-facing functions are redundantly provisioned and software builds are reproducible. Sites are version-controlled and monitored for changes. HTTP/2 and automated LetsEncrypt.org certificates are deployed on all hosted sites.
